



Floriade Spectacular Tour

Day 1

Our Coach will meet you at Bay 4, Eddy Avenue, Central Station, at 9.30am or at Strathfield Station, Everton Road, at 10.00 am. Travel along the Hume Highway through the Southern Highlands to Mittagong RSL where we stop for lunch (own expense) before passing through Canberra and heading south. We follow the Great Dividing Range into the Monaro Plains with wonderful scenery down the Monaro Highway to Cooma for your first delicious dinner in our beautiful Top of the Town restaurant, which has outstanding views over Cooma and surrounding countryside.

Day 2

Today we head up to the mountains. First we visit Yarrangobilly Caves where we tour the 2 million year old beauty of Jillabeanan Cave possibly Australia's most beautiful cave and the most accessible for all ages including wheelchairs. Then we travel to Cabramurra - Australia's highest township for a picnic lunch. We also visit the goldfields of Kiandra and the quaint village of Adaminaby.

Day 3

Today we travel to Canberra to meander through the magnificence of Floriade and enjoy the visual delights of spring in our National Capital. Visit a National Icon of choice, and afterwards drive along the shores of Lake Burley Griffin and past several Embassies before our journey back to Cooma.



Day 4

This morning we are off to board the charming historical Cooma Rail Motor for a joyful ride across the Monaro plains. We visit the Snowy Hydro exhibition and see the audio-visual about the Snowy Mountains Scheme. Then we go back to the motel for a delicious lunch. Then it's off to Cooma Gaol and a fabulous insight into penal history at the Gaol Museum, leaving just enough time for checking out the avenue of flags, the mosaic time-walk and some shopping.

Day 5

Back up to the Mountains today and first stop will be the interesting township of new Jindabyne, then Thredbo Alpine Village, viewing the spectacular Crackenback Range, and on to Perisher Village and Charlotte Pass to see five of Australia's highest peaks. (subject to visibility and accessibility.)

Day 6

We commence our journey home after saying goodbye to the friendly staff at the Motel. We provide a packed lunch to enjoy en route, and arrive at Eddy Avenue (Central Station) between 3.00 pm and 4.00 pm.
