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HIGH COUNTRY MOTEL WALKING ON THE ROOF ADVANCED

Day 1

Our coach will meet you in Canberra and travel to Cooma via the scenic Monaro plains. Relax at "The Overflow" cocktail lounge then enjoy a hearty dinner at our dining room with views of the town.

Day 2

Kosciuszko Walk – then along the Main Range Track

Total of 19 km hard walk

Kosciuszko & return 13 km only

This walk will go from the top of the Thredbo chairlift to the summit of Mt Kosciuszko, then along the Main Range Track to Charlotte Pass.



On a clear day there are spectacular views to the west. We will pass several of the glacial lakes then stop for a break at the lookout of the deepest of the five lakes, which is Blue Lake.

This is a challenging scenic walk. For guests that want to return to Thredbo after reaching the summit can with a guide. The coach will be there to meet the returning walkers and then continue on to pick up the remaining group at Charlotte Pass.



Day 3

**Namadgi National Park
Orroal Valley**

Total of 9km 3.5km uphill walk

This is an interesting walk to the former Geodetic Observatory. There are some great views from the lookout over the Orroal Valley.

After the groups return to the Valley, we visit the old Homestead where we should be able to observe a large number of Eastern Gray kangaroos grazing.

Day 4

Lambie Bush Track

Total of 9.5km return walk

Today we stay around historical Cooma and surrounding hills. In the morning we take the Lambie Bush Track. There are several lookouts where the township of Cooma and surrounding hills can be observed. On our return trip to the Motel we walk up to Nanny Goat Hill for another spectacular view of the area. After a buffet lunch at the Motel, we explore fascinating and historical Cooma with a guide.

Day 5

Bournda National Park

Total of 9km walk

The Kangarutha track offers an outstanding coastal walk through the northern section of Bournda National Park between Turingal Head and Kianniny Bay. The undulating path takes us through the heath land and tea trees. Small bays will invite the visitors for a rest and if the weather permits, we can wade in the pristine waters of the Pacific Ocean. After we arrive at Kianniny Bay, if time permits, we will visit the recently restored Historic Warf at Tathra.

Day 6

We commence our journey home after saying goodbye to the friendly staff at the motel. In Canberra we see Parliament House, Lake Burley Griffin and several embassies then board the train back home.
